Animations are lots of pictures combined together to make movement. Each picture is called a frame and each frame is slightly different from the other. Flip books are a type of animation. Cartoon movie animations are made with computer programs. Years ago, technology was not the same as it is today and a lot more work was involved in making animations.

Designing and making a flip book animation

- Colour each frame from 1 to 15 with the colours listed below.
- Leave the circles white.
- Draw a different facial expression in each circle, "example" happy, angry, sad, silly, scared, surprised.
- Accurately cut along all the lines in the grid and sort the frames from 1 to 15.
- Make sure all the edges are lined up correctly, then use a stapler to attach all the frames like a book.

3 & 11 turquoise

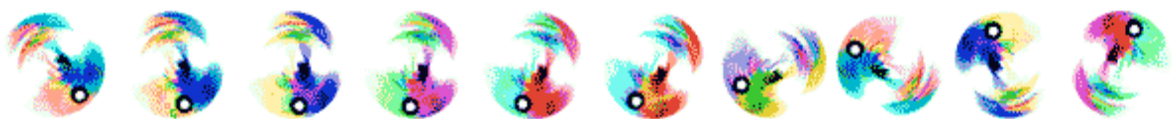
