Make a colour-mixing disc.

- Cut a medium size circle from white, stiff paper or cardboard.
- Cut a hole in the middle big enough for a pencil to fit.
- The cardboard should be able to spin freely on the pencil.
- Draw 16 equal divides on your cardboard.
- Alternate the colours blue and yellow, you should have 8 blue and 8 yellow sections.
- Colour the other side of your disc using red & yellow or blue & red.
- Place the disc on the table with the pencil in the hole.
- Spin the disc on the pencil as fast as you can.
- What happens to the colours?
