

Teacher's Note

- Students will express different interpretations with their drawings.
- Discuss the different pictures students drew. How many students drew similar pictures?

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ One student could make a scribble on a piece of paper and hand it to another student. That student is to make a drawing out of the scribble. Lots of fun.
- ❖ Start drawing something on the blackboard or white-board. Stop at intervals so students can try to guess what you are drawing. Make it as difficult as possible.
- ❖ Make a group picture. Each student is going to draw a picture related to a topic. Perhaps the city, farming, sea creatures, insects or birds. When every body has finished their picture arrange them on the wall of the class so they look like one big picture.
- ❖ Visit a local art gallery.
- ❖ Invite an artist to give a few drawing tips and show students some of his/her artwork.
- ❖ Face painting is popular and a challenge to do it properly. Have a bash at it.
